WHEREAS, City Council desires to study the feasibility of establishing a public parking area or areas within the North Main Street Corridor in an effort to bolster customers to visit existing businesses and encourage new businesses to come to the area; and,

WHEREAS, the improvement of any parcel for use as a public parking area or areas would be required to conform with the City's applicable Tree and Landscape Ordinance, buffer requirements and zoning ordinances for the establishment of public parking; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council this 16th day of December, 2014, that the Traffic Safety Committee and City staff shall coordinate a study on the feasibility of establishing a public parking area or areas with the North Main Street Corridor; such parking area or areas shall conform with the City's applicable Tree and Landscape Ordinance, buffer requirements and zoning ordinances for the establishment of public parking; and input shall be obtained from the businesses and residents of the North Main Street Corridor to meet the parking needs of the North Main Street Corridor.
