

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2009-008**

*Authorizing consumption of beer and wine at the Capital City Music and Wing Fling to benefit the Carolina Cooperative Ministry in Capital City Stadium*

WHEREAS, David Britt ("Sponsor") is sponsoring the Capital City Music and Wing Fling to benefit the Carolina Cooperative Ministry in Capital City Stadium from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsor has requested permission to allow the consumption of beer and wine beverages by its patrons at the event from 12:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 4th day of March, 2009 that the sale of beer and wine is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. and the sale of food is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 11, 2009 in Capital City Stadium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all pets shall be prohibited. Patrons are prohibited from bringing food, non-alcoholic beverages, alcoholic beverages, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups, grills and radios, boom boxes and other musical devices, backpacks and large bags; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time that Capital City Stadium shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation,

Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Capital City Stadium is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which beer and wine may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply.






