

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2013-029

Approving the honorary naming of the Woodlake Drive Bridge  
the "Chappelle Heath Manning Bridge"

WHEREAS, Chappelle Heath Manning was born on January 22, 1928, and died May 25, 2008 at age 80. He was the eldest son of Katharine Heath Manning Perry and Burwell Deas Manning. He attended Episcopal High School and the University of Virginia. He served in the United States Marine Corps during World War II; and,

WHEREAS, upon his return from military service, he began his career in real estate and was the founder of C. Heath Manning Real Estate, Inc., later renamed The Manning Company, Inc. where he was the developer of Lake Katharine, Deaswood, Woodland Hills, Drexel Lake, Dutch Square Mall, Wildewood and Woodcreek Farms, and portions of Heathwood; and,

WHEREAS he also founded Palmetto Utilities, Inc. which was instrumental in the growth of northeast Richland County and Mr. Manning, through various building companies, constructed hundreds of homes in the metro-Columbia area; and,

WHEREAS, he served in the South Carolina House of Representatives in the early 1960s; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia wishes to recognize these contributions made by Chappelle Heath Manning to the growth and development of the City of Columbia; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia this 5th day of March, 2013, that the City of Columbia name the Woodlake Drive Bridge the Chappelle Heath Manning Bridge in his honor. The design and color of the signage shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Public Works.
