WHEREAS, she married John Montgomery Cart on July 14, 1961, and had two children: Katharine Heath Cart, now Katharine Cart Crawford, who resides in Sullivan's Island, South Carolina, and John Montgomery Cart, Jr., who resides in Potomac Falls, Virginia; and,

WHEREAS, Lelia Meredith Manning Cart participated in the family business of real estate development and construction over the years; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia wishes to recognize these contributions made by Lelia Meredith Manning Cart to the growth and development of the City of Columbia, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia this 5th day of March, 2013, that the City of Columbia name the Quail Lane Bridge the Leila Manning Cart Bridge in her honor. The design and color of the signage shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Public Works.


