

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2013-032

Amending Resolution No.: R-2005-028 Establishing a policy for term limits for members of city boards, commissions, committees and development corporations

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-2005-028, approved on July 20, 2005, the Mayor and City Council established a policy and term limits for members of city boards, commissions, committees and development corporations; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to amend Resolution No. R-2005-028; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 26th day of March, 2013 that Resolution R-2005-028 establishing a policy for term limits for members of city boards, commissions, committees and development corporations is hereby amended as follows:

1. That City Council shall not appoint any person other than a City Council member to more than two (2) consecutive full terms upon any board, commission, committee, corporate board of directors or like body, unless otherwise permitted by the by-laws or rules of such body. Individual City Council members may serve for any number of full terms City Council determines, in its sole and exclusive discretion, that the person's service has been exemplary and further service beyond two (2) consecutive full terms would be beneficial to the board, commission, committee, corporate board of directors or like body, or the person is positioned to assume a leadership role after having served two (2) consecutive full terms.
2. No person, other than a City Council member, may serve upon more than one such board, commission, committee, corporate board of directors or like body at any time, unless otherwise permitted by the bylaws or rules of such body.
3. Persons appointed to fill unexpired terms are eligible for reappointment for complete terms.
4. A member may continue to serve until his or her successor has been appointed.
5. All members shall adhere to the same ethical standards as the members of City Council.
