

ORDINANCE NO.: 2001-021

*Repealing Ordinance 99-096 granting encroachment
to Joseph B. Rosen at 830 Laurens Street*

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 99-096 enacted December 15, 1999, Joseph B. Rosen was granted the right to improve with paving and landscaping an unopened portion of right of way of College Street adjacent to his property located at 830 Laurens Street, Richland County TMS #11405-12-01; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that this use of the unopened portion of right of way of College Street would not be in the best interest of the public and adjoining property owners;
NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina this 21st day of February, 2001, that Ordinance 99-096 is hereby repealed.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.




