

ORDINANCE NO.: 2001-048

*Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,
Chapter 5, Article II, Building and Technical Codes, Division 5,
Electric Code, Sec. 5-111, Adoption; conflicting provisions*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 20th day of June, 2001, that Chapter 5, Article II, Building and Technical Codes, Division 5, Electric Code, Sec. 5-111, Adoption; conflicting provisions, of the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, is amended to adopt the 1999 Edition of the National Electric Code published by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA).

Sec. 5-111. Adoption; conflicting provisions.

(a) There is hereby adopted for the city the National Electric Code, 1999 edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), which code is published separately in book form and is adopted by reference as though copied fully in this section. Any provision not specifically excluded above which concerns the qualification, removal, dismissal and duties of the building official or any other city official or employee are deemed excluded from this section. A file of record of this code is in the office of the city clerk and building official.

(b) In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the code adopted by this section and other applicable provisions of this Code, state law or city ordinances, rules or regulations, other applicable provisions of this Code, state law or city ordinances, rules or regulations shall prevail and be controlling.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.
