

ORDINANCE NO.: 2002-017

Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,  
Chapter 12, Article II, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Division 1, Generally,  
Sec. 12-42, Storage of commercial vehicles on streets

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 17th day of April, 2002, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 12, Article II, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Division 1, Generally, Sec. 12-42, Storage of commercial vehicles on streets, is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 12-42. Storage of commercial and other vehicles on streets.**

No person shall store or permit to be stored any commercial vehicle, recreational vehicle or trailer of any size or description, upon any of the streets of the city. For the purpose of this section, storage shall mean the leaving or parking of such vehicle unattended on a street for a longer time than two hours, day or night.

For the purposes of this section, the term "street" shall include any area within the street right-of-way including the area between the curb-line and adjacent property lines.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.
