

ORDINANCE NO.: 2006-007

Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 18, Redevelopment Commissions to repeal Article III, Columbia Neighborhood Redevelopment Commission, in its entirety

WHEREAS by Ordinance 89-46, adopted August 2, 1989, Columbia City Council created the Columbia Neighborhood Redevelopment Commission; and

WHEREAS the area of operations for the Columbia Neighborhood Redevelopment Commission consists of all areas within the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, not contained within the redevelopment area known as the Congaree Vista; and

WHEREAS the Columbia Neighborhood Redevelopment Commission has been inactive for a number of years; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of Columbia City Council to evaluate the question of whether one or more new redevelopment commissions should be established for more compact and discrete geographical areas of the City; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Community Development law the area of operations of redevelopment commissions established by municipal action cannot overlap; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 15th day of February, 2006, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 18, Redevelopment Commissions is amended to repeal Article III, Columbia Neighborhood Redevelopment Commission, in its entirety.

This ordinance is effective as of final reading.




