

ORDINANCE NO.: 2007-041

Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IX, Graffiti Sec. 14-269, Ease of removal provisions and to delete Sec. 14-271, Exempt property in its entirety

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 27th day of June 2007, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IX, Graffiti, Sec. 14-269, Ease of removal provisions is amended as follows:

Sec. 14-269. Ease of removal provisions.

- (a) Utility colors and paint type. Any gas, electric, telephone, water, sewer, cable, telephone and other utility operating in the city shall paint its above-surface metal fixtures with an industry-recognized paint type and color.
- (b) Condition encroachment permits. All encroachment permits issued by the city shall, among such other things, be conditions on:
 - (1) The permittee's application of an anti-graffiti material to the encroaching object of a type and nature that is acceptable to the city manager, or the city manager's designee.
 - (2) The permittee's immediate removal of any graffiti;
 - (3) The city's right to remove graffiti or to paint the encroaching object; or,
 - (4) The permittee's providing the city with sufficient matching paint and/or anti-graffiti material on demand for use in the painting of the encroaching object containing graffiti.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Sec. 14-271, Exempt property, is deleted in its entirety.


