

ORDINANCE NO.: 2008-030

*Amending the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina,
Chapter 17, Planning, Land Development and Zoning, Article III, Zoning,
Division 3, Board of Zoning Appeals, Sec. 17-114, Appeals from decisions of board*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 2nd day of April, 2008, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of The City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter 17, Planning, Land Development and Zoning, Article III, Zoning, Division 3, Board of Zoning Appeals, Sec. 17-114, Appeals from decisions of board, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 17-114. Appeals from decisions of board.

Any person who may have a substantial interest in any decision of the board of zoning appeals, or any officer or bureau of the city having authority, may appeal from any decision of the board to the circuit court in and for the county by filing with the clerk of such court a petition in writing setting forth plainly, fully and distinctly wherein such decision is contrary to law. Such appeal shall be filed within 30 days after the decision of the board is mailed.




