

**ORDINANCE NO.: 2008-060**

*Allowing for hospitality cabinets (mini-bars) in qualified facilities  
within the City limits of the City of Columbia*

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code Ann., Chapter 6 , Alcoholic Control Act, Title 61, Alcohol and Alcoholic Beverages, Subarticle 8, Hospitality Cabinets, requires approval of the City of Columbia to allow "qualified facilities" as defined by §61-6-2300(4) to sell alcoholic beverages in sealed containers by means of a hospitality cabinet located in guest rooms, if the conditions of Chapter 6 are met; and,

WHEREAS, Columbia City Council desires to give approval to allow qualified facilities within the City limits of the City of Columbia to sell alcoholic beverages by means of hospitality cabinets; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia this 16th day of July, 2008 approval is hereby given for "qualified facilities" as defined by §61-6-2300(4) to sell alcoholic beverages in sealed containers in individual portions to its qualified registered guests by means of a hospitality cabinet located in the rooms of these guests if the conditions of Chapter 6 are met.

This ordinance is effective upon final reading.




