

RESOLUTION

RELEASE AND ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF THE CITY'S EXISTING 15' WATER MAIN EASEMENT ALONG LEXINGTON COUNTY TMS#02797-01-010 FOR THE HARBISON SPRINT BUILDING; CF#243-25

WHEREAS, heretofore the City of Columbia entered into an agreement with The Harbison Development Corporation for the construction of water mains to serve Harbison New Town. The City constructed 16" and 18" water mains along Harbison Boulevard (formerly known as the East-West Connector) under Projects #W26, W33, W37 and #WA255; and

WHEREAS, construction plans for the referenced Harbison Sprint Building conflicted with the location of the City's existing 15' water main easement and were approved by the City on the condition that a portion of the water main would be relocated; and

WHEREAS, a new water main was constructed in accordance with the approved construction plans. The new water main and easement were conveyed to the City by Southern Realty Development Corporation on March 16, 2000 and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Lexington County on March 20, 2000 in Record Book 5698, page 177; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested that the City release and abandon that portion of the existing 15' water main easement along the subject property where the water main has been relocated; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council this 19th day of April, 2000, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, each to the other paid, and the granting of a new 15' water main easement to the City of Columbia, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the City of Columbia hereby remises, releases and forever quitclaims unto SOUTHERN REALTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, its successors and assigns, that portion of the existing 15' water main easement as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

Said easement plat also being on file in the office of the Department of Engineering under file reference #243-25.


