*Authorizing application for State Mass Transit Funds*

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia currently operates two transit stations for the benefit of transit passengers; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue operating a City center trolley shuttle bus service to enhance mobility and support economic development in the downtown area; and,

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Department of Transportation Mass Transit Division may apportion to the Columbia Urbanized Area State Mass Transit Funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City has available funds which may be used to match the State Mass Transit Funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, this 20th day of December, 2000, that the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to submit an application to the South Carolina Department of Transportation Mass Transit Division for State Mass Transit Funds to help support the operation of the City of Columbia's transit stations and the City center trolley shuttle bus service for the fiscal year 2001-2002.




