

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2002-012**

*Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages and outdoor concert  
for Columbia Museum of Art Contemporaries' Third Thursday Concert*

WHEREAS, the Columbia Museum of Art is sponsoring the Contemporaries' Third Thursday Concert at the intersection of Hampton Street and Main Street from 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 18, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, the Museum has requested permission for the temporary closing and use from 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. of the 1400 and 1500 blocks of Main Street between Taylor Street and Washington Street and the 1100 and 1200 blocks of Hampton Street between Assembly Street and Sumter Street, for staging of the event; for patrons to consume beer and wine during the event hours of 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m.; and, for crowd control and overflow; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 13th of March, 2002, that the sale of beer and wine beverages is authorized between the hours of 5:30 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 18, 2002; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups shall be prohibited; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portion of

Gadsden Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Part 2, Article D, Division II, Sections 2-2052 through 2-2054, 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Section 2-2047(2)(b), 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, that portion of the 1400 and 1500 blocks of Main Street between Taylor Street and Washington Street and the 1100 and 1200 blocks of Hampton Street between Assembly Street and Sumter Street, with the exception of the parking areas and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Section 2-2047 shall not apply. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated.


