

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2002-046**

*Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages and outdoor concert for the  
Columbia Music Festival Association on Saturday, August 24, 2002*

WHEREAS, the Columbia Music Festival Association ("Association") is sponsoring a concert in the 900 block of Pulaski Street between College Street and the common boundary of its building located at 914 Pulaski Street and of Vista Commons, on Saturday, August 24, 2002 from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the Association has requested permission for the temporary closing and use of the portion of the 900 block of Pulaski Street between College Street and the common boundary of its building at 914 Pulaski Street and of Vista Commons from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 24, 2002, for preparation of the event; and from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. for patrons to consume beer and wine beverages at the event, and for crowd control and overflow; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 7th day of August, 2002, that the sale of beer and wine beverages is authorized between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 24, 2002; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portion of Gadsden Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Part 2, Article D, Division II, Sections 2-2052 through 2-2054, 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Section 2-2047(2)(b), 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, that portion of the 900 block of Pulaski Street between College Street and the common boundary of 914 Pulaski Street and of Vista Commons, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Section 2-2047 shall not apply. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Code Section 2-2046, et. seq., 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.


