

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2002-064

Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages at Fall Rally in the Vista

WHEREAS, Palmetto Place Children's Emergency Shelter, Willy's Oyster Bar and Harley Haven ("Sponsors") are sponsoring the Fall Rally in the Vista on Sunday on November 10, 2002 from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. to benefit the Palmetto Place Children's Emergency Shelter; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsors request permission for the temporary closing and use of the portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Pulaski Street and Park Street for preparation and staging of the event to allow patrons to consume alcoholic beverages at the event; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 2nd day of October, 2002, that the sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 10, 2002; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Pulaski Street and Park



Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the closed portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Pulaski Street and Park Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina



Dear Ms. Plaugh:

Once again, Palmetto Place's Children's Emergency Shelter is working with Willy's Oyster Bar and Harley Haven on the "Fall Rally in the Vista." This event is a bike rally featuring food, beverages and live music with proceeds benefiting Palmetto Place. Nearly 3,000 people have attended these rallies in the past.

To adequately prepare for and safely handle this type of crowd, we respectfully request the following:

- (1) closure of Lincoln Street between Gervais and Lady Streets and Lady Street between Pulaski and Park Streets on Sunday, November 10, 2002, from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. The actual event takes place from noon to 6 p.m., but we are requesting the additional time in order to set up and tear down the event.
- (2) issuance of a resolution to designate this area for the consumption of alcoholic beverages, and denying use of coolers, glass containers and the presence of pets.
