

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2002-069

Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages and Parrot Palooza Festival Mouth outdoor concert for Jillian's in Gadsden Street at Gervais Street, on Saturday, October 26, 2002

WHEREAS, Jillian's is sponsoring the Parrot Palooza Festival Mouth outdoor concert in the 1100 block of Gadsden Street on Saturday, October 26, 2002 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:30 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, Jillian's has requested permission for the temporary closing and use of the portion of the 1100 block of Gadsden Street adjacent to its building from 7:00 a.m. Saturday, October 26, 2002 until 2:00 a.m. Sunday, October 27, 2002 for preparation of the event; and on Saturday, October 26, 2002 from 6:00 p.m. 11:30 p.m. for patrons to consume beer and wine beverages at the event, and for crowd control and overflow; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 16th day of October 2002, that the sale of beer and wine beverages is authorized between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 26, 2002; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portion of Gadsden Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Part 2, Article D,

Division II, Sections 2-2052 through 2-2054, 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Section 2-2047(2)(b), 1979 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, that portion of Gadsden Street adjacent to Jillian's, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Section 2-2047 shall not apply.

Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated.


