Authorizing Fall and Holiday Downtown Magnolia Markets

WHEREAS, City Center Partnership, Inc. ("City Center") desires to hold Fall and Holiday Downtown Magnolia Markets on Saturdays September 6, 13, 20 and 27, 2003 and December 6, 2003 from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. within the 1100 block of Hampton Street between Main Street and Assembly Street for family entertainment and sales of prepared foods, baked goods, produce, plants and arts and crafts (excluding alcoholic beverages, beer and/or wine); and,


WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 6th day of August, 2003, that during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays, September 6, 13, 20 and 27, 2003 and December 6, 2003, City Center is authorized to hold its Fall and Holiday Downtown Magnolia Markets for family entertainment and sales of prepared foods, baked goods, produce, plants and arts and crafts (excluding alcoholic beverages, beer and/or wine) in the 1100 block of Hampton Street between Main Street and Assembly Street; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that sidewalks shall not be obstructed for pedestrian traffic in violation of Code Sec. 22-72, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Code Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no vendor locations be allowed on any street during the period of the sidewalk sales.



The City Center Partnership respectfully requests that City Council consider the following street closings for events to be produced by the City Center Partnership Inc.

We request that the portion of Hampton Street located between Main Street and Assembly Street be closed to vehicular traffic from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on Saturdays for the Fall and Holiday Downtown Magnolia Markets. The Fall Saturday event is proposed to begin on September 6, 2003 and continue each Saturday through September 27, 2003. In addition, we would like to hold a Holiday Market on Saturday, December 6, 2003.

The Magnolia Market will be a Saturday morning free public market featuring family entertainment, prepared foods, baked goods, fresh produce and plants, and arts and crafts. We will recruit vendors from existing downtown businesses and the Columbia metropolitan area.
