

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2003-061**

*Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages at Fall Rally in the Vista*

WHEREAS, Carolina Sunshine for Children, Willy's Oyster Bar and Harley Haven ("Sponsors") are sponsoring the Fall Rally in the Vista on Sunday on October 26, 2003 from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. to benefit the Carolina Sunshine; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsors request permission for the temporary closing and use of the portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Park Street and Gadsden Street from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for preparation of the event; and staging of the event to allow patrons to consume alcoholic beverages at the event from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 15th day of October, 2003, that the sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 26, 2003; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Park Street and Gadsden Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic



beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the closed portion of Lincoln Street between Gervais Street and Lady Street and Lady Street between Park Street and Gadsden Street, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sponsor shall be responsible for clean up within a one block radius around the festival area.


