

**RESOLUTION NO.: R-2004-041**

Authorizing the Columbia Museum of Art and Junior League of Columbia, Inc.  
to hold Building Brighter Tomorrows Cultural Enrichment program

WHEREAS, the Columbia Museum of Art and the Junior League of Columbia, Inc.  
("Sponsors") are sponsoring the Building Brighter Tomorrows Cultural Enrichment program on  
Friday, September 17, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsors have requested permission to close the 1500 block of Main  
Street between Hampton Street and Taylor Street and the 1100 block of Hampton Street  
between Main Street and Assembly Street from 1:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. for preparation of the  
event and for staging of the event to be held from 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Friday,  
September 17, 2004, and for the sale of food and non-alcoholic beverages at the event by local  
downtown restaurants; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 18th day of August, 2004, that between  
the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Friday, September 17, 2004, Sponsors are authorized  
to hold the Building Brighter Tomorrows Cultural Enrichment program within the 1500 block  
of Main Street between Hampton Street and Taylor Street and the 1100 block of Hampton  
Street between Main Street and Assembly Street, and for local downtown restaurants to sell  
food and non-alcoholic beverages within the event area; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area.

All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds,

bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups shall be prohibited; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that sidewalks shall not be obstructed for pedestrian traffic in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina during the event.






