

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2004-053

Authorizing Eau Claire Renaissance Faire at Ensor-Keenan House on Friday, October 1, 2004 and at Hyatt Park on Saturday, October 2, 2004 and consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Ensor-Keenan House on Friday, October 1, 2004

WHEREAS, the Eau Claire Community Council ("Council") is sponsoring its Renaissance Faire on Friday, October 1, 2004 from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. at the Ensor-Keenan House, and on Saturday, October 2, 2004 from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. at Hyatt Park; and,

WHEREAS, the Council has requested permission to use the Ensor Keenan House on Friday, October 1, 2004 from 6:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m.; and on Saturday, October 2, 2004 for the temporary closing and use of North Main Street from Sunset Drive/Beltline Boulevard to Monticello Road and Monticello Road from North Main Street to Jackson Street from 10:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. for the Renaissance Parade; and Jackson Street from Monticello Road to Lamar Street and Lamar Street between Jackson Avenue and Kortright Street from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., for preparation and staging of the area and for crowd control and overflow at the outdoor event to be held between 10:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 2, 2004 at Hyatt Park; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such events would be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 15th day of September, 2004 that the sale of beer and wine beverages are authorized between 6:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. at the event to be held on Friday, October 1, 2004 at the Ensor-Keenan House; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area.

All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets, including snakes, shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that between 6:00 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. on Friday, October 1, 2004, the Ensor-Keenan House, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the Ensor-Keenan House, with the exception of the parking area and any other areas posted as to not allow alcoholic beverages, is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which alcoholic beverages may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only in containers provided by vendors within the areas designated. Alcoholic beverages shall be prohibited during the event on Saturday, October 2, 2004.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of
