WHEREAS, the Carolina Classic Car Show ("Sponsor") is sponsoring a car show on Saturday, August 27, 2005 in the 1300 and 1400 blocks of Main Street and 1100 and 1200 blocks of Sumter Street and Washington Street; and,

WHEREAS, the Sponsor has requested permission for the temporary closing and use of the 1300 and 1400 blocks of Main Street and 1100 and 1200 block of Sumter Street and Washington Street from 1:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. for set up and staging of the event to be held from 2:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 27, 2005; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 11th day of May, 2005, that between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 27, 2005, merchants are authorized to operate sale booths for items normally sold in their course of business, except alcoholic beverages, beer and wine, within the closed off portions of the 1300 and 1400 blocks of Main Street and 1100 and 1200 blocks of Sumter Street and Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the area. All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets shall be prohibited. Alcoholic beverages, coolers, glass bottles, breakable glasses and/or cups, large bags

and backpacks shall be prohibited; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.



SUBJECT: Street Closing for Carolina Classic Car Show

I met with Matt Kennell, Don Bomer of Marriott, Michael Roh of the Columbia Art Museum, Representative John Scott, Jr. and members of the Carolina Classic Car Show on Tuesday, April 26, in reference to their street closing request. It was a very positive and productive meeting with all agreeing with the below listed recommendations.

Carolina Classic Car Show. Close Main Street between Hampton and Lady Streets. Close Washington Street between Assembly and Sumter Streets. Close Lady Street between Assembly and Sumter Streets on Saturday, August 27, 2005 from 1:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. I also recommend the standard resolution for the Carolina Classic Car Show that prohibits alcohol, bicycles, coolers, glass bottles and skateboards. The sponsors of the event will have street vendors selling food and merchandise, but have requested that alcohol not be consumed or served during the event (2-1C)

During the meeting I also informed the sponsors that they need to coordinate the event with the Columbia Police and Fire Departments, Traffic Engineering and other city service providers when planning this event.

Abstract: This report describes the results of a series of experiments on the interaction of alpha particles with matter. The experiments were carried out using a cloud chamber and a scintillation counter.

The results show that the range of alpha particles in air is approximately 3.5 cm for a source of 5 MeV alpha particles. The range in other materials is also determined, and it is found that the range is proportional to the square root of the atomic number of the material.

The energy loss of alpha particles in matter is also studied, and it is found that the energy loss is proportional to the square of the atomic number of the material.


