

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2005-028

Establishing a policy for term limits for members of city boards, commissions, committees and development corporations

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 20th day of July, 2005:

ORIGINAL
STAMPED IN RED

1. That City Council shall not appoint any person other than a City Council member to more than two (2) consecutive full terms upon any board, commission, committee, corporate board of directors or like body, unless otherwise permitted by the by-laws or rules of such body. Individual City Council members may serve for any number of full terms.
2. No person, other than a City Council member, may serve upon more than one such board, commission, committee, corporate board of directors or like body at any time, unless otherwise permitted by the bylaws or rules of such body.
3. Persons appointed to fill unexpired terms are eligible for reappointment for complete terms.
4. The foregoing prohibitions shall not apply to the boards of the Sumter-Columbia Empowerment Zone or Community Promotions Advisory Committee.
5. A member may continue to serve until his or her successor has been appointed.




