WHEREAS, City Center Partnership, Inc. ("City Center") desires to hold "Main Street Marketplace" on Fridays October 7, 14, 21 and 28, 2005 from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. along the sidewalk of the 1500 block of Main Street for family entertainment and sales of prepared foods, baked goods, produce, plants and arts and crafts (excluding alcoholic beverages, beer and/or wine); and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 14th day of September, 2005, that during the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Fridays, October 7, 14, 21 and 28, 2005, City Center is authorized to hold its Main Street Marketplace for family entertainment and sales of prepared foods, baked goods, produce, plants and arts and crafts (excluding alcoholic beverages, beer and/or wine) along the sidewalk of the 1500 block of Main Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that sidewalks shall not be obstructed for pedestrian traffic in violation of Code Sec. 22-72, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Code Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, and that no vendor locations be allowed on any street during the period of the sidewalk sales.


