

RESOLUTION R-2005-071

Requesting Woodcreek Farms and surrounding areas in Northeast Richland County be designated as Columbia by the United States Postal Service

WHEREAS, the municipal limits of the City of Columbia currently extend into Northeast Richland County along Spears Creek Church Road, with future expansion anticipated as development and service need requirements increase; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service has designated the areas of Northeast Richland County as outlined on the attached map with a mailing address of "Elgin, South Carolina, 29045"; and,


WHEREAS, the majority of the Woodcreek Farms development is located within the City limits of the City of Columbia with the remainder to be annexed into the City as development occurs; and,

WHEREAS, commercial and residential developments along Spears Creek Church Road are in the process of annexation into the City limits of Columbia; and,

WHEREAS, there is much confusion created when properties located in the Northeast Richland County area are within the municipal boundaries of the City of Columbia and have a mailing address of "Elgin, South Carolina, 29045"; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia this 16th day of November, 2005 that the United States Postal Service be, and it is hereby, respectfully requested to change the city mailing designation of all properties located within the area of Northeast Richland County as shown on the attached map from "Elgin, South Carolina, 29045" to "Columbia, South Carolina, 29045".
