BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 6th day of June, 2007 that the City Attorney's Office is authorized to file a lawsuit against the International Council of African Professionals ("ICAP") to collect Four Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-one and No/100 (\$4,731.00) Dollars, costs and attorneys fees.




