

RESOLUTION NO.: R-2007-046

*Authorizing consumption of alcoholic beverages and
Five Points Association's 5 After 5 Fall Concert Series*

WHEREAS, the Five Points Association is sponsoring its 5 After 5 Fall Concert Series on Thursday evenings August 30, 2007 through October 31, 2007 with the exception of Thursdays, September 6, 2007 and October 4, 2007.

WHEREAS, the Association has requested permission for the temporary closing and use of Harden Street at the entrance to Saluda Avenue from 5:30 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. and Greene Street at the entrance to Saluda Avenue between 5:30 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. for preparation of the area for an outdoor event, and for patrons to consume alcoholic beverages at the event during the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 15th day of August, 2007 that the sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Thursdays beginning August 30, 2007 through October 31, 2007, with the exception of September 6, 2007 and October 4, 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only pedestrian traffic will be allowed within the 600 block of Harden Street from Devine Street to Blossom Street . All other traffic, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mopeds, bicycles, skate boards, and horses, except police horses, is prohibited. All pets, including snakes, shall be prohibited. Coolers, glass bottles

and breakable glasses and/or cups shall be prohibited; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the closed portions of Harden Street at Saluda Avenue and Greene Street at Saluda Avenue shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the closed portions of Harden Street at Saluda Avenue and Greene Street at Saluda Avenue are deemed to be the site of a public festival at which beer and wine may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.






