*Authorizing consumption of beer and wine at the  
National Bike Month Celebration at the Top of Finlay at Finlay Park*

WHEREAS, the Palmetto Cycling Coalition ("Sponsor") is sponsoring a National Bike Month Celebration at the Top of Finlay at Finlay Park from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 28, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, Sponsor has requested permission to allow the consumption of beer and wine beverages between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. by its patrons at the event; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such an event would be in the public interest; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council this 28th day of May, 2008 that the sale of beer and wine is authorized between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 28, 2008 at the Top of Finlay at Finlay Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all pets shall be prohibited. Patrons are prohibited from bringing coolers, alcoholic beverages, glass bottles and breakable glasses and/or cups, grills and radios, boom boxes and other musical devices, backpacks and large bags; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all vendors be restricted to stationary location; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the designated time the Top of Finlay at Finlay Park shall be declared to be a Public Park and provisions of Chapter 15, Parks and Recreation, Sec. 15-1, 15-2 and 15-3, Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina are in effect. Pursuant to Chapter 14, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions,

Article IV, Offenses Against the Public Peace and Order, Sec. 14-99, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, the Top of Finlay at Finlay Park is deemed to be the site of a public festival at which beer and wine may be consumed and the prohibition against possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages as set forth in Sec. 14-99 shall not apply.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no solicitation or transactions be made in violation of Sec. 14-32, 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina.


