WHEREAS, Mr. Shlon's dedication to Columbia and the University of South Carolina is obvious with a host of awards and memorabilia from the Best of Columbia awards, commemorations from the City, the Columbia Housing Authority, Lexington 2, WIS-TV, the University of South Carolina, Richland 1 adorning the walls; and,

BE IT RESOLVED this 15th day of March 2016, that the Mayor and City Council do hereby approve the honorary naming of the 2000 block of Greene Street between Laurens Street and Harden Street "Andy Shlon Street".
